Public Authority's Mission Statement:

The Niagara County Brownfield Development Corporation (NCBDC) is a not-for-profit corporation formed in October 2008 by the Niagara County Legislature. The NCBDC was created to establish and operate the Niagara County Brownfields Cleanup Revolving Loan Fund (BCRLF) program. Through the BCRLF, the NCBDC provides financial assistance in the form of low-interest loans and subgrants to eligible entities for remediation of brownfield sites throughout Niagara County. Revitalizing and returning brownfield sites to productive use creates jobs, contributes to the tax base, and eliminates the potential risk to public health and the environment.
