

Hudson River Park Trust Mission Statement and Performance Measurements

As set forth in the Hudson River Park Trust's enabling legislation, Hudson River Park Act, Chapter 592 of the 1998 Laws of New York, the mission of the Hudson River Park Trust is to encourage, promote and expand public access to the Hudson River, to promote water-based recreation, and enhance the natural, cultural, and historic aspects of the river from Battery Place to West 59th Street in New York City for residents and visitors to the area. The Trust has authority over the planning, construction, operation and maintenance of Hudson River Park.
