# EXPLANATORY STATEMENT CIRCUMSTANCES OF DISPOSAL BY NEGOTIATION OF REAL PROPERTY REFERENCE NO. TN22-2, UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE NEW YORK STATE THRUWAY AUTHORITY, TO THE COUNTY OF ROCKLAND

#### Introduction:

Public Authorities Law section 2897, subsection (6)(d)(i)(B) of the Public Authorities Law (hereinafter, "PAL") requires that an explanatory statement be prepared of the circumstances of each disposal by negotiation by a public authority of "any real property that has an estimated fair market value in excess of one hundred thousand dollars."

- 1. Description of the parties involved in the property transaction: New York State Thruway Authority (Authority) and the County of Rockland (County).
- 2. Justification for disposing of property by negotiation: Pursuant to PAL §2897(6)(c)(v), the Authority is permitted to dispose of real property by negotiation when the requirements of a less than fair market value transaction pursuant to PAL §2897(7) are met.

The proposed transaction is a less than fair market value transfer, the transferee is a government or other public entity, and the terms and conditions of the transfer require that the ownership and use of the asset will remain with the government or any other public entity. The Authority has no current or foreseeable future need for the Property. Transfer to Rockland County will provide Rockland County with clear title for all portions of the new Rockland County Highway Department Facility.

- 3. Identification of Property, including its location: The Subject Property, shown on the map attached hereto as Exhibit I, is an irregular configured landlocked parcel improved with an asphalt parking and circulation area, curbing, storm drains, landscaping and slope stabilization materials and is located within the new County Facility located at 26 Scotland Hill Road, Chestnut Ridge, NY 10977. It is situated adjacent and north of the on/off ramps for Thruway Interchange 14A (Garden State Connector) near mile post 23.4± of the Thruway mainline (Hudson Section- I-87/I-287) in the Village of Chestnut Ridge and the Towns of Ramapo and Clarkstown in the County of Rockland.
- 4. Estimated fair market value of the property: \$725,000
- 5. Proposed sale price of the property: \$1-payment waived.
- 6. Size of the Property: 2.225± acres

7. Expected date of sale of property: 3rd Quarter of 2024







Being a portion of the property acquired in fee by virtue of Parcels No. 1353 of Map No. 1353, Parcel No. 1354 of Map No. 1354 and Parcel No. 1416 of Map No. 1354, which maps were filed in the Office of the Clerk of Rockland County on September 14, 1956 & April 17, 1957, and being a portion of Parcel No. 1325 of Map No. 1325 which was filed in the Office of the Clerk of Rockland County on April 26, 1957.

Access to the property is strictly prohibited along its southern boundary, the courses and distances of which are described hereinabove. Access, therefore, is permitted across all other courses and distances and boundaries described hereinabove. There is no access to the property from the Thruway.

The above mentioned survey baseline is a portion of the 2019 survey baseline for the construction of the Rockland County Highway Department Capital Project No. 3414 Highway Department/Emergency Operations Facility as shown on a map and plan on file in the Office of the Rockland County Highway Department and described as follows:
